2009-2010 Faith In Action Scholarship Application Information

Thank you for your interest in the Faith Community Church scholarship program. Up to three scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded annually. Our goal is to award two of these scholarships to graduating high school seniors from a high school or home school from either St. Croix or Polk counties. An additional scholarship will be available to a currently enrolled college/vocational student with a permanent residence in either St. Croix or Polk counties.

Scholarships are designed to assist students in their academic endeavors beyond high school in preparation for a career and/or life style that will be God honoring. Post-secondary matriculation can occur at a Christian college, private or state university, or vocational school.

Completed applications must be submitted to Faith Community Church by the close of the business day on Monday, March 2nd 2009 for consideration by the selection team in April of 2009.

Applicants must complete Part # 1 and #2 of the attached application. In addition, all applicants must submit two references from non-related people that address the applicant's character. This may include references to the applicant's extra curricular activities or involvement in professional organizations that have enhanced the applicant's spiritual growth and contributed to the welfare of others. Reference letters may be included with the final application package or mailed directly to the church office. Applicants may include additional information that could help the selection process. Faxed information will not be accepted. Application forms are available online at www.homeforever.org.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient after verification of completing one semester of full time post-secondary education with a GPA of 2.0 or higher. An official transcript or grade report will suffice as documentation. The recipient should include a statement detailing their participation in at least one extra curricular organization reflecting the recipient's commitment to spiritual growth and a continued walk with Christ.

Scholarship decisions will be based on the applicant's Christian testimony, academic standing, educational goals, involvement in community, and how these factors are supported through references.
